Retrieving a few programs that the wind has blown through the office door, it wouldn't be fair not to point to

KHJ's Inglewood Park Concert at 7:30 tonight. The theme is to be "Sons of the Vikings," where we will find Frederick Stark directing his orchestra and singers in thirty minutes of songs of the North.

And if you've left the table before that, why not KECA at 7, when Mildred Loughlin is to be contralto soloist with a concert orchestra under the direction of Charles Shepherd, an ensemble, too, that should not fail to please?

If you've stolen a nap just after supper, awaken at 8, dial KNX and you'll listen to a dramatic playlet entitled "Water," an Indian story laid in the desert centering around the drying up of the wells. It is tabbed "intensely dramatic."

In radio parlance "as the gong sounds it will be exactly 8:30," three stations, KHJ, KMTR and KFWB, "go concert." First up, KHJ with KFRC sending down "the traditional music of England." Charles Bulotti sings "Duna," "All Joy Be Thine" and others. KMTR points to Justin Johnson's Salon Group with a galaxy of classics, including Nevin's "Narcissus" and Dinnli's "Mystery of Night."

And as the same gong sounds 8:30, KFWB tells us, "We present Eddie Ward, renowned pianist and known for his musical scores for the pictures 'Kismet,' Irene Bordoni's 'Paris' and 'The Lady in Ermine.'" He'll "anecdote" play and everything.
