the return of a new series of "Cof-
fee Matinees," with Berna Fretch-
ette, soprano, and a marimba band
under the direction of Joseph Hor-
nik featured. During this broad-
cast Miss Fretchette will be presented
in three solos, one a South Amer-
ican tune and the other two more
familiar American popular songs.

If you'll then break away from
the supper table at 7:30—KHJ with
its Inglewood Park concert will bring
a half-hour of music, an all-Amer-
ican program in honor of Columbus.
Columbus will be featured leaving
Spain, the voyage and discovery as
told in a descriptive fantasy "Col-
umbus" under the baton of Fred-
erick Stark. If you are still con-
cert minded, stay with KHJ and
at 8:30, KFRC, the Don Lee sta-
tion in San Francisco, bids for
your ear with an all-oriental pro-
gram featuring Charles Bulotti sing-

soprano, will sing a real Chinese
song, "Jasmine."
