Friday is replete with evenly bal-
anced programs offering a few va-
rieties and, of course, the radio regu-
lars. No East Indian princes or
Honorable This and Thats, but we'll
ticket a few that lift their heads a
bit above the others.

As you give the kids a hick and a
kiss just before they clatter school-
ward at 1 o'clock forget the lunch-
eon dishes and dial KHJ. You'll find
a Columbia program titled "Light
Opera Gems," a full half-hour, in-
cluding selections from De Koven's
"Robin Hood," Herbert's "Red Mill"
and "Mill Modiste." Channon Col-
linge will direct this half-hour with
a number of vocalists including
Rhoda Arnold, Helen Nugent, Earl
Palmer and Crane Calder.

And now we'll skip through the
afternoon—touching KFI at 6:30, an
N.B.C. regular—and here's the way
it reads: "What's Keeping My
Prince Charming?" from "Rhapsody
in Black," and "Forgotten" are solos
to be offered by Ruth Lyon and
Leslie Arnold. The program prom-
ises other high lights when a quar-
tet sings "Blue Danube Waltz" and
"Gypsy Love Song." Koestner's or-
chestra closes with the "Italian
Street Song."

At 7:30 I'd switch to KHJ and a
lot of nonsense titled "Laughing
Gas," with Elvia Allman, the Three
Cheers and xylophone. They com-
bine to wreck the studio. It's a
retreat from the serious, an escape
from some dramatic soprano doing a
swan song.

And here's something new—KNX
at 7:45 breaks out in this vein: "At
last the long-heralded Bobrick girls
—hilariously funny skits — Jeannie
and Jean—portrayed by Mary Duck-
ett and Mora Martin." The funniest
theme in the world—love.
