Well, tonight's Blue Monday Jamboree is dedicated to "Politicians." At 5 p.m. over KHJ New York sends us the ceremonies attendant upon the presentation by the Columbia Broadcasting System of a medal to Leopold Stokowski, director of the Philadelphia Symphony Orchestra. Brief remarks—and then a program of Stokowski's favorite selections by the Columbia Symphony Orchestra.

Stepping back into the midafternoon—point to KFI at 3. Clyde Pangborn, who flew across the Pacific from Tokio recently with Hugh Herndon, will join Herndon in speaking to the people of Japan during an exchange of programs between the United States and Japan. Herndon speaks from New York at 3: a concert with Irving Kennedy and a Japanese trio from the San Francisco studios at 3:10; from Tokio you will hear a Japanese program—and then another contribution from N.B.C.'s San Francisco studios. One hour that should hold a bit of interest for you.

The dramatic skit—titled "Merrit and Marge"—from Columbia's New York studios—KHJ at 7:45 tonight. A back-stage story of two chorus girls—good plays and skits are scarce—it's a new series—let's hope.

As for the Blue Monday Jamboree—you should be thrilled at least with the drama by the Deep Dramatic Stock Company. "Cold Turkey" or "The Stuffed Ballot Box" has never been presented before—it will be tonight.
