

# THANKSGIVING DAY PLEA GETS GREAT RESPONSE

## Broadcast for Quick Assistance Brings Bountiful Food Supply to Hungry Church Crowd

Instantaneous response to an appeal over radio KHJ at 5:20 p.m. Thanksgiving afternoon fed 500 people.

Father Morin of Our Lady of the Angels Catholic Church appealed to the Tower of The Times Thanksgiving afternoon, asking that we tell the good folks over the air that many, many poor families were appealing to his church at the Plaza—families who otherwise would have had to go without food, and some without shelter, if the good father could not obtain relief for them.

While The Times news period seldom is devoted to asking anything of its listeners, you will all agree that no better use of a moment of that time could have been made than asking a bit of food for those who were in want on the day of thanks.

### APPEAL BROADCAST

At 5:20 that afternoon we shoved a few murder items aside—devoting a moment to appealing to Radioland—asking that they send or deliver themselves what food they could spare to the little Catholic church at the old Plaza. On the wings of the air this simple appeal sped throughout the Southland—and the response was remarkable.

We have just telephoned Father Morin at the moment of this writing asking what response was had to our appeal. It makes us happy to tell you that everything from a horse and buggy to a Rolls-Royce rolled up to the old church—hearted of Radioland bringing their tithe of food to help out.

More than seventy boxes of food were contributed. Nearly 500 people were helped over the hill. Tables were spread with bountiful Thanksgiving food and, best of all, the little children who would have had to have gone without went to sleep that night with tummies full of the good things. Each and every donor would have felt well repaid for their effort if they could have witnessed the happy smiles on the faces of both the old and young that were prompted by the gifts.

### RADIO PLEA ANSWERED

Radio reached out into the night and on its airy waters surged back with food for those in want. It may seem of slight moment that your table groaned with food—and yet, who knows where lightning may strike? Perhaps some day, although we hope not, you, too, may be an appellant at the court of misfortune—and wouldn't radio then be a worth-while thing to you?

Can't you picture the old and young, babies and grandfathers, crowding the patio of that little old Catholic church—asking for food? Radio tapped the land of plenty . . . and touched the hungry's eyes with contented sleep.
