The works of Schubert and Mendelssohn will be featured. This program is to be transmitted from the Philadelphia Academy of Music and will include short talks by music critics describing the program and the scene at the academy.

Don't miss The Merrymakers tonight. KHJ has concocted thirty minutes teeming with the station's stars and including skits and blackouts. Malaria and Ebenezer will drift in. The first half of the opera "Barnyard" will be given along with songs and patter. In fact, in recognition of the fiftieth anniversary of The Times, KHJ has prepared a special high-light program for this half-hour.

And if you simply have to weep and tangle a laugh or two with your tears, Columbia's "Showboat" over KHJ at 7:15 tonight gives promise of a real good opportunity for both.
