First, KHJ offers the entire fourth act at 1 p.m. If you are not at home then, why not stay up a bit tonight for KTM's presentation of the high spot musical and dialogue selections from this classic at 11:30? The cast will journey from the Figueroa Playhouse to the studio for both programs. There will be forty voices and an entire orchestral group.

Which brings us to the bankers' banquet and prize fight. Fight fans will dial KFVB at 9:30 tonight, when Messrs. Sandy Garrison Casanova and Harry Smith are to go ten rounds or less in a battle that should furnish plenty of excitement.

Exactly fifteen minutes later—KHJ at 9:45—the bankers' banquet at the Roosevelt may bring you short talks on present conditions—or just the clatter of tableware.

At least it's a radio night for the slippers-and-fireside devotees.
