Breaking into the day with the Los Angeles Breakfast Club Frolic, you can drift into a half-hour of Russian music, attend a United States Navy Band concert, then slip into the evening discovering Jackie Cooper, child screen star; Irene Bordoni, and a host of excellent concerts.

First up, I'd point to KPFWB at 8 a.m., when the Breakfast Club hails the Mexican polo players and officers of the Canadian Club. Ham and eggs, entertainment, well-known speakers—and well—they have everything from a musical humorist to a Canadian baritone.

While at 11:30 over KHJ, Columbia's American School of the Air—one of the best known works of Alexander Pushkin, the famous Russian poet—is to receive a dramatization. These half-hours are primarily for grammar and high school children—but the art display is worthy of anyone's attention.

Jackie Cooper, the favorite of every child and many oldsters, who is now starred in "The Champ," will be the feature guest on Uncle John's Children's Hour—KHJ at 6 tonight. Two other featured artists on this hour will be Viola Von, "Wild Rose," and Mercedes Marjote, "The Little Boy-Girl"—bringing again to Radioland the songs and recitations that in the days of old KHJ held the attention of thousands of listeners-in. And there's Santa Claus, too.

And for concerts and varieties—a world of them.
