With the observance of Christmas Eve throughout the Southland today and tonight, radio's magic will aid in flooding homes with the joy of the yuletide.

Scanning a musical menu that would prompt hesitation in selection, I'd suggest dialing KHJ at 10:30 o'clock this morning for a half-hour of the National Press Club Christmas Carols—from Washington. A group of forty voices, recognized as one of the country's outstanding choral organizations, will be heard under direction of Albert W. Harnod.

Scanning the dial, I'd still stay with KHJ at 1:30 this afternoon to receive the American Legion Christmas greetings. This feature also will originate in the national capital and is to include short talks by Secretary of War Hurley; Secretary of the Navy Adams and Brig.-Gen. Hines, chief of the Veterans' Bureau.

Turning the dial, you'll not regret tuning in on the lighting of the White House Christmas tree. KECA at 2 p.m. points to this event—which will embrace talks by President Hoover, Vice-President Curtis and numerous compositions by the United States Marine Band.

Still sticking to the high spots, why not KFI's dramatic musicale at 6 o'clock tonight? This is an N.B.C. feature offering the yuletide classics of five of the world's greatest composers.

And for Christmas plays, both KECA and KPWB offer attractive features. Dickens's "Christmas Carol" is the masterpiece on KPWB's schedule for 9 p.m., while KECA offers "Dust of the Road" at the same hour.

As a finale KECA at 8:55 tonight will broadcast the chimes of old Trinity ringing in New York City.
