Christmas Bills Also to Link America and England

National Cathedral Services Slated for Broadcast

Operas and Oratorios Among Array of Offerings

"God's in His Heaven, all's right with the world" resounds throughout the nation today via radio. Paean of tribute to the Nativity will ring out in our Southland from London, Washington and last—but far from least—arise in the studios of local stations.

Throughout America and England a portion of the Christmas festival services of the National Cathedral on Mount Saint Alban will be heard, to be broadcast here over KHJ at 8:30 o'clock this morning. Here is a bit of the classic program:

- "Adeste Fideles"
- Sermon by Bishop Freeman.
- "O, Little Town of Bethlehem."
- "Before the Heavens Were Spread Abroad."
- "Praise God From Whom All Blessings Flow."

Special musical offerings fitting for the occasion will be rendered by the Cathedral Choir of Men and Boys.

OFFERING FROM LONDON

Then with the last strains of that sacred program, London, England, is to flash over the Atlantic with its Christmas contribution—KHJ at 9:30—when Gilbert K. Chesterton broadcasts a special address on Charles Dickens.

Which brings us to 10:30 when, over KNX, there will be a remote-control broadcast of high mass from the Cathedral of St. Vibiana including a rendition by the choir of Beethoven's Mass in C. Most Rev. J. J. Cantwell, bishop of Los Angeles and San Diego, will officiate.

Or, if you prefer opera, why not KECA at 10:45 this morning? The complete opera "Hansel and Gretel" is to be presented from the stage of the Metropolitan Opera House in New York City.

ORGAN PRESENTATION

I'd not miss KFI at 11:30 this morning when a master of the organ, Edwin H. Lemaire, is scheduled for a recital. This special Christmas half-hour is to include the first movement of Schubert's Unfinished Symphony, and Andantino in D Flat, Mr. Lemaire's own composition.

Lacking information, I'm puzzled a bit—"Aladdin Pantomime" is the title of a special feature announced by KECA for 12:40 p.m. A little mystery doesn't hurt, however, and as it comes all the way from London, let's venture a dialing—we may be agreeably surprised.

Two Oratorios that give promise of serving this Holy Day are offered by KECA. The first is set for 2:15 this afternoon: "Christ The King" by Father Verhaegen, a Benedictine monk. At 4 o'clock a half-hour described simply as "Christmas Oratorio" is to be offered. Both originate in the eastern studios of the National Broadcasting Company.

DRAMATIC FEATURE

For a play—I believe I'd dial KHJ at 7:15 tonight. "The Picture" is the title, with locale in Germany—just after the Armistice. A competent cast has been selected and its a bit of variety to please.

Closing, we might point to noon again—KHJ at 12—when a duplication of the annual ceremony around the great Sequoia in the high Sierras will be offered from the studios of KFRC, San Francisco. Held about a 5000-year-old giant in Gen. Grant National Park, the entertainment will include Meredith Willson's orchestra, Eleanor Allen at the organ and Robert Olsen's rendition of "Trees."
