As you pass into the afternoon, why not adventure a bit and dial KFI at 3:45 and again at 5. Here are two National Broadcasting features titled, "Music Garden" and "Fine Arts String Quartet." Not a bit of information on the two programs, but we may be agreeably surprised.

Slipping into the evening, I'd like to listen to Columbia's "The Dancers"—KHJ at 6:30—perhaps it's music that will tempt the toes and sharpen the appetite.

From then on—well, let's frisk the High Lights—there's a world of variety.

And the Blue Monday Jamboree is a galaxy of the outstanding acts, skits, songs and musical numbers of all their 1931 presentations. There's a riot in itself I wouldn't miss for a barrel of sopranos or Senators.
