Stepping back into the early afternoon—as a special feature of The Times Forum at 1:30 you may expect a greeting to Southern California from Julien C. Hyer, president of the International Lions Clubs. Hyer is here on his first official visit to district No. 4, comprising California, Nevada and Hawaii, and over the radio will extend his invitations to all listeners-in.

The International Lions Clubs will hold their annual convention for the first time in Los Angeles July 19 to 22, and President Hyer and Secretary-General Melvin Jones of Chicago are in town to complete arrangements for this gathering which is expected to bring some 1000 visitors just before the Olympic games.

In addition, the Forum will present Miss Grace Kingsley, writer of "Jobnobbing in Hollywood" and "Gemma chat in The Times dramatic columns. Miss Kingsley will give a few "lowdowns" on the movie colony personages in her own inimitable manner.
