Florey Walker, noted world traveler who has hobnobbed with Mustapha Kemal in Turkey, Thomas Masaryk in Czechoslovakia, and others, is a high light at the Breakfast Club (KFWB at 8.) while for entertainment Jimmie Barr in song hits, Eddie Mahoney, pianologue numbers, and Marc Collier, the noted American tenor, step up to the mike.

Do you want to bring a battle into your front room? KECA at 4:15 this afternoon reaches across the Pacific into Manchuria, hails Floyd Gibbons to a battlefield microphone and the war is on. This is an epochal broadcast and when better wars are made they will be broadcast, too. Floyd is billed to corner Gen. Honjo of the Japanese military forces, who will address you in Japanese, to be translated later into English by Gibbons. If an enemy shall find the microphone don't telephone the station to find out why the broadcast was discontinued. Unless adverse weather or shell conditions interfere—be there at 4:15. Almost anything is apt to happen.

As the gold of the day melts into the copyrighted blue of the night, we want to congratulate KHJ on revamping its Resinol Hour. With its singing star, Anita Stewart of the screen, the music of Raymond Paige and his orchestra, and the melée of melody provided by Vera Van, the Bluettes and the Bachelors Quartet, all forms a high light worth more than passing mention.

While for those growing heavy-lidded at 9:30 tonight turn to KHJ embark on KOIN'S barge to the "Isle of Golden Dreams," a soft beautiful half-hour of South Sea melodies, with the voice of Bob Hains in pleasing song.

The Times Forum period today at 1:30 will present Edwin Schallert drama editor of The Times, who will discuss briefly the entertainment situation here, especially what the immediate future holds both for stage and screen fans. Also, the Forum will feature the usual mid-week talk by Dr. Frank McCoy. The Forum tomorrow will feature a talk by Mayor John C. Porter, who will have something to say of interest to every citizen, voter and taxpayer of Los Angeles.
