A United States Senator, music and science, dancing at both Palm Beach and Miami and the Standard Symphony weekly concert are included in today's broadcast schedule.

Senator Wagner of New York is to inaugurate National Thrift Week with a discussion of "Life Insurance Day," to be heard locally over KHJ at 8:45 a.m. George S. Van Schaick, superintendent of insurance for the State of New York, will introduce the Senator.
