Over land and sea radio today flashes tribute to Abraham Lincoln. But there are in addition the bobsleds and skis in the Olympic Winter Games at Lake Placid and a trip to the Metropolitan Opera house, in New York City, to hear the second act of "Tannhauser," with Maria Fritza singing.

KHJ at 8:30 a.m. will take listeners-in to the top of Mt. Hoevenberg, from which vantage point Ted Husing will describe the final heats of the bobsled races. With these honors won, KHJ will shift to Invervale Jump, near Lake Placid, at noon, for the results of the ski jumping championship competition.
