Trading skates for opera will prove the forecast feature of radio today. The final contests of the Olympic winter games being held at Lake Placid, N. Y., and the awarding of honors will vie with a presentation of Gounod's opera, "Faust." Unfortunately, they cross each other on the air, but a bit of both may be had by watchful dialing.

For the final Lake Placid hockey matches dial KHJ at 11:15 a.m. Ted Husing will describe the icy sports; to return again over KHJ at 12:45 for the ultimate gesture of this part of the Olympic Games.

Mme. Elisabeth Rethberg, soprano; Georges Thill, tenor, and Leon Rothier, basso, are the opera stars heading the cast to be heard in "Faust," the second and third acts of which will be broadcast over KECA at noon. The broadcast is to be made direct from the stage of the Metropolitan Operahouse, New York City. Deems Taylor, noted music critic, will comment during the performance.

The Times Forum will present its regular Saturday afternoon feature, Mrs. G. U. Purdy's talk on contract bridge. The Forum is on the air this afternoon over KHJ, but not until 2:10 o'clock. In connection with the bridge talk an important announcement of interest to all devotees of the game will be made.
