Two visits to Washington, the first for lenten services and the second for a half-hour with the United States Army Band; "Romeo and Juliet, the always enjoyable Standard Symphony concert, and, going back into fairy tale lore, the operetta, "Little Red Riding Hood," over KFRC, are among today's broadcast features.

A series of presentations, arranged by the New York Protestant Episcopal City Mission Society in cooperation with the Columbia network, will bring to the radio audience an outstanding prelate in the Episcopal Church each Thursday at 9:45 a.m. over KHJ. Today Rt. Rev. William T. Manning, bishop of New York, is to be heard.

While no program has been released for the United States Army Band concert, listeners will find in this half-hour (KHJ at 1 p.m.) a bit of relaxation from hair tonics and finger waves usually rampant at this hour.

Again the Capulet and the Montague families are to wage their bitter feud, and again Romeo and Juliet will pledge their love. KFVB at 9 o'clock tonight is to weave a radio version of Shakespeare's immortal play of love. The identity of the cast will be disclosed at the end of the play.
