The debut of new Columbia series in a narration of night life on two continents while KFVB celebrates its seven birthday anniversary and Irvin Co. and Sophie Tucker will be heard.

International broadcasting will take its place in the American School of the Air (KHJ) at 11:30 when audiences throughout the country will first hear an address on the fishing industry, delivered in Washington, and then step into the studios of the British Broadcasting Company in London, England to hear Commander Stephen King-Hall, a prominent international speaker on "The Changing British Empire."

"Beau Bachelor," a new romantic series of adventures against a background of night clubs and pleasure spots of two continents, will be inaugurated over KHJ at 7 tonight. In the opening episode, laid in the Cafe de Paris, "Beau's" friends are bidding him a noisy farewell as he starts his journey to America. This is a national network release from the Columbia studios in Chicago.

For KFVB's birthday party a parade of the best of the station stars will bid for your dial from 8:45 until 10 p.m. tonight. Jerry King, manager of KFVB, is master of ceremonies.

The Times Forum, on at 1:30 this afternoon over KHJ, will present Kyle Palmer, political writer of The Times, who will review events in that field, now getting pretty hot. Also Dr. Philip M. Lovell, editor of Care of the Body in The Times Sunday Magazine, will give some pertinent health advice.
