Breakfast Club Frolic Will Start Day's Programs

Diversity is the keynote of today's radio, the program starting at 8 a.m. with a frolic at the Los Angeles Breakfast Club, followed with a concert by the United States Navy Band at Washington, a recital by that master of the piano, Percy Grainger, and finally a drifting away from the day's labors on KOIN's barge to the Isle of Golden Dreams at 9:30 tonight.

Leo Carrillo, Gov. Rolph, Tom Mix and his circus act, Gordon Berger, baritone, Pietro Gentile and a host of speakers to the tunes of Arthur Kay and his sixty-piece orchestra come up with the sun at the Los Angeles Breakfast Club (KPWB at 8 a.m.) Albertino Pickens, star of "Hoo-Doed," lifts the lid of good will with "Smile, Darn You, Smile."

While its programs are never released in advance, a journey to Washington to attend the United States Navy Band concert is never disappointing. KHJ at 1 this afternoon issues the invitation and it is well worth a dial.

Percy Grainger will be featured as pianist, composer and arranger when he appears as guest artist over KFI at 6:30 tonight. Several of his own works, including the popular "Country Gardens" and Tschai-kowsky's "Waltz of the Flowers" will be featured.

The Times Forum at 1:30 p.m. will especially appeal to the family in that it covers matters of interest to home folks. Marshall Stedman, instructor in dramatic art, who has been actor, cinema star and radio feature, will talk on talk—in other words, discuss correct speech, especially common errors and those developed by children. And Helen King, on the staff of Farm and Garden, The Times agricultural magazine, will tell how to have a flower garden for \$1.
