Second Act of "Sadko" to Be Heard From Metropolitan

Philadelphia Symphony Also Among Offerings for Day

The Rimsky-Korsakoff opera, "Sadko," from the stage of the Metropolitan Opera-house, New York City, and the Philadelphia Symphony Orchestra concert lead today's parade of radio high lights. In addition there will be a bit of song by Bing Crosby, the farewell of Roy Kellogg's Gilmore Circus of the Air, the Giants and Cubs and the Merry-makers' weekly endeavor to promote smiles.

KECA at noon will link listeners-in with the Metropolitan Opera-house, in New York City, for the second act of Rimsky-Korsakoff's opera, "Sadko." Georges Thill, French tenor of the Metropolitan, is to sing the role of the wandering gousli (believe it or not) player, Sadko. Incidentally the "gousli" is a native Russian musical instrument. An array of Metropolitan stars should make this a real treat.

KHJ at 5:15 p.m. will release a concert by the Philadelphia Orchestra under the baton of Leopold Stowkoski, originating in the Philadelphia Academy of Music. The program is to be all-Russian and will include the following:
