Wandering down the air lanes today come the Boswell Sisters, a dramatization of the life of Alfred the Great, United States Senator Robert M. La Follette, Jr., Gov. La Follette, the Pickard family from Tennessee, a drama featuring Mae Bush and the Blue Monday Jamboreaders.

With the calling to class of the American School of the Air (KHJ at 11:30) a historical dramatization based on the deeds of Alfred the Great will be presented. Six million school children are said to listen in on these splendid educational releases.

For concerts, perhaps the most outstanding will prove to be KHJ at 7:30, when, in addition to the singing of Alex Gray, the Boswell Sisters are guest artists. Not to be outdone, however, KFI at 6:30 reaches down into Tennessee for thirty minutes of southern melody and brings a family of hill-billy folk to insure a pleasant program.

Reputations will be torn asunder, homes broken up, private lives bared. All of this and more is threatened by the Blue Monday Jamboree (KHJ at 8 tonight). Astride the waves of the air, these funsters will tear the paper off the wall and tell you why Mrs. Brown or Mrs. Short changed husbands, addresses, telephone numbers and other things beneath the rose.
