radio features. A scanning of the dial for the evening reveals the Inglewood Park Concert Orchestra lending its art to Irish melodies in honor of St. Patrick; two good plays and a special Easter release from the University of California at Los Angeles.

Capt. Dobbsie's Ship of Joy will steam out on the radio sea (KHJ at 8 a.m.) freighted with a special program to include an address by Gov. Rolpin. A feature of the program will be the presentation to Capt. Dobbsie of a gigantic birthday cake, which measures approximately eight feet in diameter and stands more than eight feet high. The captain is preparing a gala program for this celebration.

Because St. Patrick's Day will have passed before the Inglewood Park concert comes around again, Frederick Stark is to direct the presentation of a rich array of Irish melodies tonight at 6:30 over KHJ.

The play series titled "Heroes of the Olympics" (KHJ at 8:45) is "packing them in." Tonight's episode is heralded as the most dramatic of the group: How an Olympic princess founded the games for women, with the offer of Nomaus, king of Elis, to give his daughter's hand to anyone who could defeat him in the chariot race.
