Two St. Patrick's Features From Dublin on Day's List

De Valera Message Will Be Heard From Emerald Isle

Program for "Times" Forum Also in Nature of Tribute

Having driven the snakes from Ireland in the long ago, St. Patrick takes the radio spotlight today.

Two programs from Dublin, Ireland, and the majority of the national network features regularly scheduled for the day will salute Erin's patron saint.

The first international broadcast from Dublin is to be heard over KHJ at 11:30 a.m., when school-children assembled in classrooms throughout the nation, as well as listeners in their homes, will hear a bit of Irish singing. Choirs from the Richmond-street schools in Dublin will open with "The Harp That Once Through Tara's Halls," and conclude with two songs in Gaelic, "Rinncé Philió an Cheoil" and "An Crann Ubbhall." Annie Fagan, distinguished harpist, will include the ever-popular air, "The Minstrel Boy," among her solos. Patrick Kirwan, who many think ranks next to John McCormack in the roster of Irish tenors; Seamus Glandillon, baritone, and Seamus MacAonghusa, playing the pipes, are to contribute the remainder of the program.

At noon KHJ offers a St. Patrick's Day message from Eamon De Valera, newly elected President of

the executive Council of the Irish Free State. This message is to be brought from the Free State broadcasting service, located in the Postoffice Building, Dublin.

Over KFI at 7 o'clock music from the Emerald Isle is scheduled, by the Lucky Strike

the Siamsa Gael Band, drivin' in from Dublin.
