Radio's high lights today range from tennis to opera.

Ted Husing steps to the microphone at 11 o'clock this morning (KHJ) to spend two hours and a half describing the national indoor tennis finals, being held at the Seventh Regiment Armory, New York. This event should prove of great interest in Southern California, where tennis is a favorite sport.

KECA at 1 p.m. will carry the broadcast from the Metropolitan Opera House in New York City. There Meyerbeer's opera, "L'Africaine," is to be staged, with Beniamino Gigli, tenor, in the role of Vasco Da Gama. Elizabeth Rethberg, soprano, is to sing Selika, while Ezio Pinza, bass, will appear as the Grand Inquisitor. Act IV and scenes 1 and 2 from Act V will be heard via radio. This famous opera was completed only a day before the death of its composer.

For a measure of good spirits KHJ at 9 tonight points to its Merry-makers. A host of studio stars will make their weekly attempt to smooth out the crows-feet and worry of a hectic week.
