## NEW SCORING STUDIED FOR CONTRACT BRIDGE

NEW YORK, May 2. (AP)—Leading members of the Whist Club of New York and the Portland Club of London today considered important changes in the scoring of contract bridge as proposed by Harold S. Vanderbilt, author of the present scoring system. The changes are designed to meet criticism that sacrifice bids by a nonvulnerable side are not penalized heavily enough. The club experts met primarily to work out an international code for contract.
