Linton Wells to Introduce Russians Over C.B.S.

KHJ Has Music From Beach at Waikiki Tonight

Fordham College Glee Club and New Thriller Listed

The Columbia Broadcasting System releases an unusual international program to radio station KHJ today at 1:15 p.m.

With Linton Wells, journalist, at a microphone set up in Trade Union Station No. R.W. 49, at Moscow, Russia, the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics is to greet the United States of America with Russian music and song, sweeping across Poland, Germany, France, England and our own continent: on the magic of short-wave wireless, listeners-in will be entertained with five Russian folk melodies by the Pianitsky Chorus, songs by Irma Yaousen, and three Tschaiowsky selections by Mme. Derschinsky, soprano star of the Moscow Opera, supported by the State Symphony Orchestra. As a finale to this ambitious release, there will be heard the Soviet Music Chorus, singing Shketeis' "Per-turbed Street."

KHJ again at 9:30 p.m. reaches across the Pacific to the beach of Waikiki, Hawaii, for thirty minutes with Joseph Kamakau's Serenaders. The program, titled "Hawaiian Sketches," will be transmitted by short wave from KGMB, Columbia's associated station in the mid-Pacific, to KFRC, San Francisco, and thence to KHJ. If the transmission process is successful, "Hawaiian Sketches" will become a regular Saturday night Columbia feature. The program will open with lovely hula music. "Hapa Haole Hula Girl," and will include "Heeia," "Lei Lehua" and "Uheuhene," an old and odd shouting song.

With those foreign visitors noted, a glance at the high lights will discover the debut of a new serial of murder mystery (KFWB, 8:30 p.m.) a baseball fracas between the Pirates and the Hollywood Stars (KFWB, 2:10 p.m.) and if at the luncheon hour you crave excellent glee club fare, then do not miss dialing the Fordham College Glee Club (KECA, 1 p.m.)
