Turkey Tightens Laws to Punish Kemal's Enemies

ANGORA, June 17. (AP)—The Turkish Parliament has voted a law "for the protection of the republic," providing stern punishment of plotters against the Kemalist regime.

Prison terms up to ten years are established for persons who attend meetings wherein the assassination of any member of the government is so much as mentioned.

Five to ten years in jail are promised persons found guilty of forming any associations whose purpose is the use of violence or the establishment of the sovereignty of any one social class, or the dissemination of propaganda against the national interests.
