True to tradition, the gang will show up in Radio City's dignified halls clad in flannel slacks, sport jackets and tennis dresses to keep the air of informality alive.

Western listeners will hear many of the original troupe, including the Three Cheers, Eb and Zeb (Pearce and Bill Wright), Mable Todd, Ann Andrews and Tizzie Lish. Har Foster, former tenor with Jimmie Grier's orchestra, who joined the gang before it left for the East, will be heard in solo numbers.

Followers of the Beauty Box Theater presentations will find the broadcasts on a new schedule today—KFI at 7:30 p.m.—with "The Desert Song" as the fare and Roy Bampton, Metropolitan Opera contractor, in the leading role.
