Awards for the five radio programs adjudged best of the year, which are to be announced today at the annual luncheon of the Women's National Radio Committee at the Astor Hotel, New York City, will be broadcast over Columbia and K.H.J. at 11 a.m.

This year the committee is offering five awards for the best serious musical program, light musical program, non-musical feature, children's program and educational broadcast.

Anning S. Prall, chairman of the Federal Communications Commission, is to be presented by Mrs. Harold Vincent Milligan, chairman of the committee.

She will play the role of a woman attorney. The latest "rave" in dance bands is Jack Hylton's aggregation, heard Sundays over KFI.

Those who saw the film "These Three" can attest to the capabilities of 12-year-old Benita Granville, who will make a guest appearance on KMTR at 8 p.m. She'll play the role of child spy in John Marshall's "International Spy" production. Cavalcade of America players are to dramatize the 300-year evolution of fire-fighting tactics in their current broadcast over Columbia and K.H.J. at 5 p.m. The program will open with the dramatized story of the historic Budd's fire in Philadelphia in 1736, when only the frenzied work of its citizens with their lines of buckets saved the city from destruction.
