IN THE TIMES, FEB. 10, 1890:
 The cornerstone was laid for a new Catholic orphanage in Boyle Heights.

TUCSON—Protests against allowing any of the Chiricahua Apaches (including Geronimo) held in Alabama and Florida to reside in Indian Territory was adopted by the Arizona Pioneers. The Indians could too easily escape to their old haunts, it was declared.

BERLIN—Emperor William sent a gift of 24 drums to the Sultan of Turkey. Drums had not previously been used by the Turkish army, it was said.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, FEB. 10, 1915:

A 1.58-inch rain brought the season's total to 12.28 in.

The Imperial Irrigation District bought from the Southern Pacific for \$2,152,000 the

interest of the SP in the Imperial water system.

LONDON—Reports from Bucharest said the Russian troops were evacuating Bukovina in the face of a heavy advance by Austro-German troops.

WASHINGTON—A bill for a canal across the Isthmus of Tehuantepec was introduced by Rep. Tinkham of Massachusetts. It would cut more than 1000 miles off the coast-to-coast routes.
