SIXTY YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, FEB. 20, 1890:
 H. W. Hellman retired from the firm of Hellman, Haas & Co. to take over management of the Farmers & Merchants National Bank. I. W. Hellman was to go to San Francisco to take over the Nevada Bank, but to remain president of the local institution.

SAN FRANCISCO—Reports from Lake and Mendocino Counties said storms had isolated many communities, and that residents of Lakeport were in danger of famine. At Truckee there was five feet of snow, at Grass Valley 30 inches, at Dutch Flat four feet. It was still snowing.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, FEB. 20, 1915:

SAN FRANCISCO—Despite a heavy rain, San Francisco welcomed the opening of the Panama Pacific Exposition.

ROTTERDAM—The Dutch steamer Helena was halted in the North Sea by a Zeppelin, which, after learning her identity, let her proceed.

LONDON—Replying to an American protest over use of the American flag by British vessels, the government points out that British law permits the use of the British flag by any vessels seeking to escape capture. The burden is on a belligerent to make sure of a vessel's nationality before firing upon it.

FIFTEEN YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, FEB. 20, 1935:

CARSON CITY—A bill creating a board of canine dental surgery, empowered to file back a dog's teeth to one-quarter inch in length in case he bites a person and to extract them on a second offense, was introduced in the Legislature.

WASHINGTON—Gov. Moour of Arizona filed an affidavit in the U.S. Supreme Court declaring Parker Dam would obstruct the navigation of the Colorado River.

BERLIN—Two beautiful women were beheaded as spies in the principal Nazi prison. Two men were to meet a similar fate in a few days.
