SIXTY YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, MAY 15, 1890:
 U.S. Commissioner Van Dyke decided that 11 Chinese, who had sneaked across the border from Tijuana, must be returned to Mexico. The Police Commission, after long debate, was unable to reach a decision on the matter of enforcing the ordinance against the nuisance of drivers who hitched teams on the public streets and then went away for long periods.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO
IN THE TIMES, MAY 15, 1915:
 Police Chief Sebastian, Mayorally nominee, and Mrs. Lillian Pratt were acquitted of contributing to the delinquency of a 17-year-old girl. The

Jury swiftly reached its verdict and Sebastian's friends immediately formed a huge demonstration and parade in his honor.
