WRC—11:15. Clark M. Eichelberger, director of the American Association for the U. N., is guest.

WTOP—11:35. John Stuart Mill's essay on "Utilitarianism" is discussed.

WTOP—1. Leonard Bernstein begins two-week guest conductorship of the New York Philharmonic with an all-Russian program. Pianist William Kapell is soloist.

WRC—1:30. "Victory or Disaster Through Airpower?" Maj. Alexander P. De Seversky, author of "Victory Through Airpower," and Marshall Andrews, author of "Disaster Through Airpower," debate the subject.

WOOK—1:30. The 100th anniversary of Miner's Teachers College is celebrated.

WOL—2:30. "The Key to Peace." Dr. Clarence Manion, dean of Notre Dame University Law College; Mrs. Ruth McCormick Miller, publisher of the Washington Times Herald;

Judge Michael Igoe and Riley Hughes of Georgetown University.

WMAL—7. Vincent Price plays the lead in "This Small World," a program presented on behalf of the over-

seas relief agencies of the Catholic Church. Archbishop Francis P. Keough of Baltimore also speaks.

WCFM—8. Recital of music for the double bass with Roger M. Scott accompanied on the piano by Vladimir Sokoloff. From the National Gallery. Program includes J. B. Loelliet-Meriz' Sonata, Ravel's Sonatine, Dragonetti's Concerto and, in their first Washington performances, Porter's Lyric Piece and Read's Spiritual.

WRC—8:30. "Father of the Bride" is presented from Constitution Hall with Spencer Tracy, Joan Bennett and Elizabeth Taylor in their original movie roles.

WASH and WEAM—9:30. W. Averell Harriman, special assistant to President Truman, addresses the American Association for the U. N. at Chicago.

WTOP—10:30. Hubert Hendrie is baritone soloist with the "Choraliers" in program of British and American music.
