WMAL—10:30 a. m. The Atlanta-Morehouse-Spelman combined chorus is heard. John D. Rockefeller, jr., chairman of the National Council of the United Negro College Fund, and Rufus E. Clement, president of Atlanta University, are speakers.

WTOP—11:35. Former President Herbert Hoover appears as a scholar and metallurgist in discussion of Agricola's "De Re Metallica," one of the first treatises on mining geology.

WGMS—12:30 p. m. Gluck's Overture to "Iphigenia in Aulis," Beethoven's Symphony No. 1 in C and Chopin's Piano Concerto No. 2 in F minor.

WTOP—1. Leonard Rose, who is leaving the New York Philharmonic to begin a concert career, is soloist with the orchestra in Bloch's "Schelomo." The first network performance of Norman Dello Joio's "New York Profiles," Mendelssohn's Symphony No. 3 in A minor and the prelude to Saint-Saens' "Le Deluge" are also played.
