

Thursday TV Highlights

11 a. m.—WRC-TV. Home's garden editor, Will Peigebach, shows how to decorate the outside of your house.

3:30 p. m.—WTOP-TV. Bob Crosby, the Bobcats, Joan O'Brien and the Modernaires are televised in color.

7 p. m.—WRC-TV. The crooked owner of a silver mine schemes to get paid twice for the ore from his lode. But his plan is foiled by Wild Bill Hickok.

7:45 p. m.—WTOP-TV. Jane Froman drops in on a convention in New York and sings "There's a Convention in Town." "Getting to Know You" and "Hey, There!"

8 p. m.—WMAL-TV. An elevator operator with a desire for money tries to "Pick a Winner" and his methods get him in trouble with postal inspectors in tonight's Mail Story.

8 p. m.—WTTG. They Stand Accused: A man and a woman make a suicide pact which backfires into a murder trial.

8 p. m.—WTOP-TV. Ray Milland Show: On a train bound for New York, professor McNulty meets a beautiful musical comedy star. The star's manager figures the professor is a perfect foil for a new publicity stunt.

8 p. m.—WRC-TV. You Bet Your Life: Groucho tangles with a nice young couple who've been married 11 months and have three children. When Groucho asks them if their children are triplets, they answer "yes." He comments: "It's a good thing you said that. If you said no, we might as well all go home." Also on hand are a princess from an Indian tribe, the owner of a clean-

ing establishment and a concert violinist.

8:30 p. m.—WMAL-TV. Treasury Men in Action: "The Case of the Dangerous Dollars." Story of a weak-willed engraver who switches to counterfeiting when he can't hold a legitimate job. When the T-men pick him up, they convince him he's better off on their side.

8:30 p. m.—WTOP-TV. Climax: Edmond O'Brien portrays a hurly-burly carnival man in an adaptation of William Faulkner's turbulent story, "An Error in Chemistry."

9 p. m.—WMAL-TV. So You Want to Lead a Band: Denise Lor is guest.

9:30 p. m.—WRC-TV. Ford Theater: "Girl in Flight." A costume drama in color. Joan Leslie plays a French girl, falsely accused of murder. She escapes and is befriended by her erstwhile executioner, who tries to keep her as his daughter. Well acted, with Hugo Haas outstanding as the ostracized executioner and John Qualen effective as his servant. Play seems dedicated to the philosophy that public executioners can be "Just Folks," too.

9:30 p. m.—WMAL-TV. Kraft Theater: "Kitty Foyle." Christopher Morley's appealing novel gets a fairly faithful adaptation, and a good cast, headed by Cloris Leachman and George Roy Hill (the latter also did the TV adaptation). Our heroine is a spirited Irish lass from the wrong side of the tracks, who makes the fatal error of falling in love with a Main Line Philadelphia aristocrat. The story comes through with more maturity than most.
