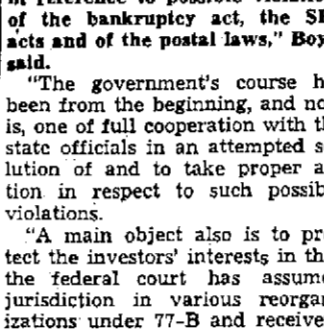

City's Tax Plan Interests Others
