Jacobs Gives Proof He Has Fight Corner

By JACK CUDDY (Copyright, 1938, by United Press) NEW YORK (U.P.)—Mike Jacobs, Lord of Launers' Lane, has arranged his first match since going into partnership with Madison Square Garden for the betterment of the breed of brawls, and a grand match it is—this Henry Armstrong-Cottino Garcia welterweight title fight.

When "Uncle Mike" wrapped up and delivered this fistic natural for the Garden on Nov. 2, he not only set a stratosphere standard of match-making to shoot at during the four years of his contract with the Garden, but also proved the power of his corner on the belt bourse.

Were it not for Jacobs' monopoly in the fight racket, it is vitally certain that Messrs. Armstrong and Garcia never would swap socks in a New York ring. If not all, Managers of both maulers, Eddie (Easy Touch) Mead and George (Pineapple Pie) Paragassus, wanted the bout staged in Los Angeles where both lads have tremendous followings. And Mead, Armstrong's pilot, wasn't anxious to have Henry tangle with the big, strong, hard-hitting Filipino any place.

Jacobs Had His Way Mead realized the danger of tossing triple-crowned Henry into a ring with savage Cottino, who through a "brawl" approach had thought to knock a man's head right up into the Garden's girders. Mead also realized the danger of risking the welter crown against an opponent who will have at least 12 pounds weight advantage—an opponent who was big enough and strong enough to whale the daylights out of Middleweight Glen Lee, the so-called "Nebraska Wildcat."

Mead figured that if he had to fight in an outdoor arena in Los Angeles where the gate probably would be much larger than the \$125,000 expected at the Garden. But Jacobs wanted the bout in New York, and he got it. For the past couple of years, Promoter Mike has been getting almost everything he wanted in boxing. And now his position is so solidified that he'll probably get e-e-y-y-y-t-h-h-n-g. Before nis

four-year combine with the Garden, many doubting Thomases along punch promenade still believe that Mike was flying so high with his promotions that he was bound to crack up. They still regarded him as a lucky fly-by-nighter. But that four-year document with the house that Rickard built impressed the boxing world with Jacobs' permanence and power on slapsnaps.

All Percentage Now That contract established Jacobs and his 20th Century Club on a far firmer financial foundation because it kayped the big rental gamble he took every year. Mike no longer has to guarantee the Garden \$125,000 annually for his boxing privileges. The Garden does the gambling now. It rent for the arena and bowl comes out of profits on Jacobs' fights, whether staged, if there are profits. No profits, no rent.

Since Mike operates with Yankee Stadium and the Polo Grounds on a percentage basis, his only financial gamble now is the operating expenses at the Hippodrome and his promotional outlay before each fight. Every fighter, incidentally, performs on a percentage basis also. There are no more guarantees to boxers since Jacobs gave Lou Ambers \$82,000 for defending his lightweight title in the carnival of champions last September.

Moreover, Jacobs now has most of the important talent corralled. He has control over such performers as Louis, Armstrong, Escobar, Apostoli, Garcia, Ambers, Farr, Barlund, Strickland, etc. During the winter, others like Hostak, Young Corbett and John Henry Lewis are expected to enter the fold.

Mike will stage fights in other cities this winter. He has working agreements with the Chicago Stadium, Detroit Olympic, Pittsburgh's Duquesne Garden, the Philadelphia Municipal Stadium and arena, and excellent connections in Los Angeles, San Francisco and Miami.
