Red Dot Five Rolls 1,094, New Record

The Red Dot Foods set a new city single game record of 1,094 pins while rolling in the Arcade Major league at the East Side alley Monday night. Their first games of 897 and 918 gave them a 2,909 tally for high team honors.

Bill Labarz forged ahead in the individual parade by collecting a 666 series. Bill replaced a 163 opener with rousing marks of 258 and 245. The Plaza five bettered the Plaza league season high by one pin when it registered 2,892 on 986, 1,015 and 921.
