President Roosevelt will bring radio's Christmas season to a climax Saturday when he broadcasts a message of cheer and goodwill to the world at 4 p. m. through the facilities of the three major networks. He will speak from the White House lawn where he will light the "National Christmas Tree."

Who's Who Among Wisconsin Birds



The Eastern Sparrow Hawk is the most beautiful of Wisconsin hawks with a many-colored dress of strikingly contrasting pattern. This small hawk is known as a Falcon by its sharp-pointed wings and rapid flight. It has bright upper parts and distinct black vertical marks on the side of the head, separated by white. It is a summer resident in Wisconsin, breeding throughout the state and occasionally found in winter. It was formerly very abundant in the state but has disappeared to a considerable extent in the more thickly parts of the state. The Eastern Sparrow Hawk breeds from the northern tree limit entirely across Canada, south to northwestern California, western Oregon, Colorado, eastern Texas and the Gulf States. It winters from southern British Columbia, central United States, southern Ontario and Massachusetts south through eastern Mexico to Panama. Its nest is usually in a hole in a tree but often in a cavity elsewhere, even in a nesting box. The Eastern Sparrow Hawk eats mice, lizards, snakes, caterpillars, beetles, grasshoppers, crickets, dragonflies and at times small birds and chickens. It is classed as chiefly beneficial. It frequents burned-over areas and has been known to subsist almost entirely on grasshoppers. The Eastern Sparrow Hawk breeds from the northern tree limit entirely across Canada, south to northwestern California, western Oregon, Colorado, eastern Texas and the Gulf States.
