Your Federal Income Tax

NO. 10 Exemption Allowed Head of a Family A head of a family is defined by income-tax regulations as "an individual who actually supports and maintains in one household one or more persons who are closely connected with him by blood relationship, relationship by marriage, or by adoption, and whose right to exercise family

In a Nutshell

WHY? Every single person or married person living with husband or wife who had net income of \$1,000 or more or gross income of \$5,000 or more or aggregate of \$5,000 or more, must file returns. If in doubt, obtain form and printing instructions from collector of internal revenue.

Income Tax Don'ts

DON'T prepare your return without first studying instructions accompanying the form. DON'T procrastinate. Early assembling of data permits a careful consideration of all tax problems.
