Born in Madison-co, Kentucky, on Christmas Eve 1809, Carson started traveling early in life and never wholly settled down. While still a baby his parents loaded Kit and their household goods into a covered wagon and moved west to Howard-co. Missouri, then on the edge of the Indian country. He learned to ride and shoot as soon as he could walk.

At the age of 15 he became a saddler's apprentice, but his restless spirit demanded action and at the age of 17 he joined a wagon train headed for Santa Fe. New Mexico. From then on he was involved in one adventure after another. While still a young man Carson served as guide to Colonel John Charles Fremont, the explorer. Later he and Fremont fought thru the Mexican war together and helped add Cali-






