Many stands of alfalfa and red clover in southern Wisconsin have been damaged this year, according to Prof. L. F. Graber, of the University of Wisconsin college of agriculture, and R. V. Hurley, county agent.

Reseeding any field showing a 50 per cent stand with a nurse crop of small grain, which is cut for hay, will not change the classification of the reseeded area.
