Canon Sued For Back Taxes MILWAUKEE (U.P.)—Former Congressman Raymond J. Cannon was named today in a federal court suit to recover \$4,215 allegedly due on back income taxes.

United States Dist. Atty. B. J. Husting said that Cannon paid in question, 1932, 1933 and 1934, but that an auditor's report showed that he still owed \$1,747 on the first year, \$700 on the second year and \$1,768 on the third.
