## New City Directory Completed

Madison's 1939 city directory, distinguished by a new feature, is being delivered to subscribers by the Wright Directory Co., of Milwaukee.

The new directory has 1,284 pages, 44,032 names, with 18 as the minimum listing age.

In the street department the publishers have inaugurated a symbol to denote tenant-owned homes, thus distinguishing them from rented property.

Special features of the city directory are the designation of homes and places of business having telephone connection, rosters of government officials, and an illustrated story of the city.

There will be the customary distribution of the directory to the free-reference libraries of other cities, the publishers announced. Copies will go to the major cities of the country, to most of the state capitals, and to numerous smaller cities in Wisconsin and bordering states. The Wright Co. maintains a complete branch of the directory libraries, with late outside directories on file for public reference, at the office of the Madison and Wisconsin Foundation.
