

Frank Morgan Will Star In Dramatic Role On News Show

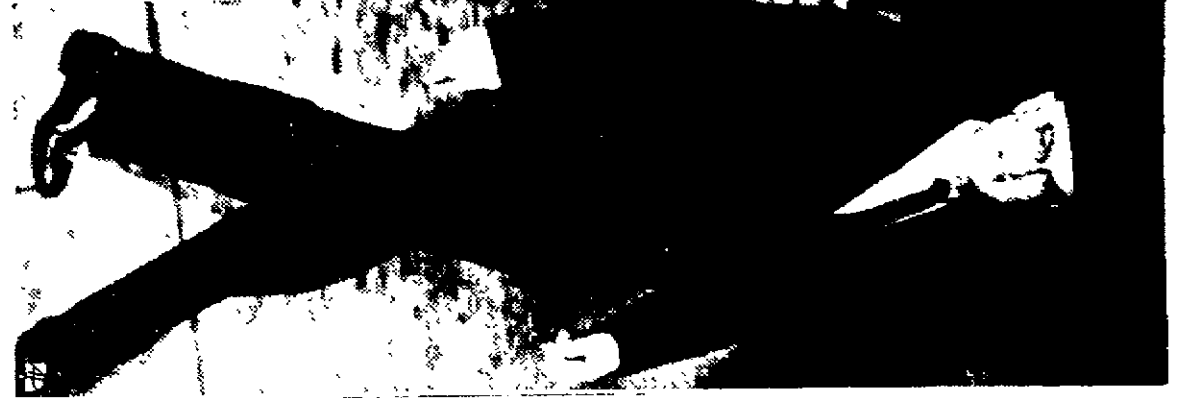
"The Magic Wallet," Chosen As Vehicle For Esthwaite Comedian; Vallee To Give English Girls Radio Chance

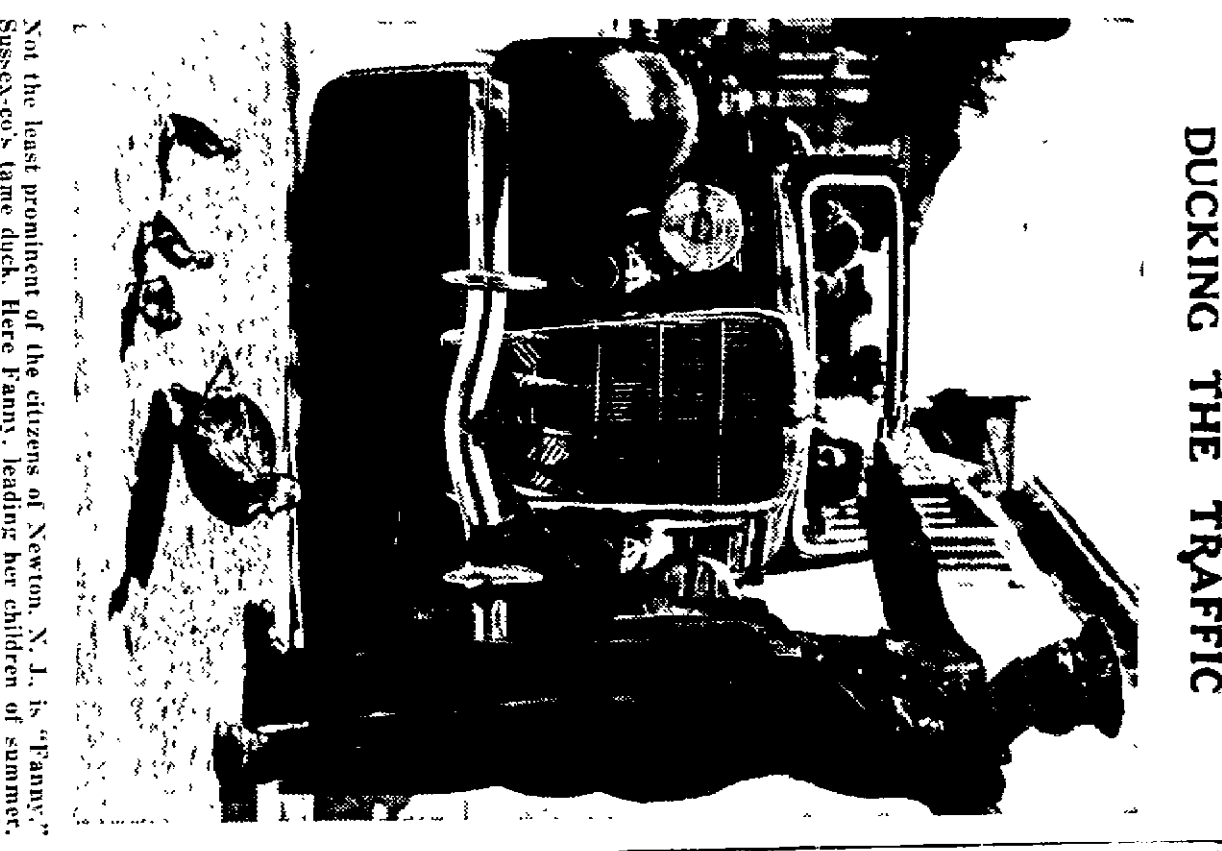
