

Thrilling Stories Set For Order Of Adventurers Hour

War Correspondent To Tell Of Escaping Firing Squad In Spain; Lowell Thomas Back From Vacation

A thrilling true story of the recent war in Spain will be told by Arthur Shields, well known correspondent, as a feature of The Order of Adventurers program over the Blue Network Monday at 7:00 p. m.

Shields remained in the battle zone during the last days of the fighting when most other foreign journalists had departed. Just before the final collapse of the Loyalist forces he was captured with a number of Spanish newspapermen.

Dr. Roy Chapman Andrews, world-famous archeologist and member of the executive board of the O. A., also plans to tell a story this week. It will deal with his exploration of the Temple of the Living Buddha in Asia, a temple so sacred that no white man is permitted to enter it under pain of death.

Commander Felix Riesenberg and Col. Theodore Roosevelt also are to be presented but Admiral Richard E. Byrd will be absent on business connected with his forthcoming trip to the Antarctic.

Lowell Thomas will return from vacation to resume his duties on the executive board.

COMPENSATION PREMIUMS CUT FOR EMPLOYERS

A reduction of 1.4 per cent in workmen's compensation premiums, affecting 91 industries, was reported today by the state industrial commission.

The reduction became possible, the commission said, because of an increase of \$680,044 in the compensation fund's surplus during 1938. The total surplus to date totals \$1,758,858, the report added.

The premium decrease, effective July 1, was accompanied, however, by an increase in rates for 60 other classifications. This was necessary, according to the report, because of a boost in accident costs.

Total assets of the workmen's compensation fund were placed at \$58,350,621. During 1938, a total of \$13,368,312 was distributed in claims of workmen and their dependents.

KIDNAP VICTIMS QUIT JERUSALEM

JERUSALEM, July 31 — (UP) — The Rev. Gerald R. Goldner of Akron, O., and his father, the Rev. Dr. Jacob H. Goldner, started today for Haifa, from where they will leave for Greece tomorrow.

A. L. Miller of Sioux City, Ia., who is general Y. M. C. A. secretary here accompanied them.

The Goldners were kidnaped by Arab bandits. The elder Goldner was released shortly after their capture so that he could arrange for ransom, but the son was held for seven days.
