Gold Story Headlines Initial Broadcast of 'Strange As It Seems'



A rare, almost unbelievable story about the existence of 28 quadrillion dollars—\$28,000,000,000,000,000—worth of unclaimed gold will headline the premiere broadcast of "Strange As It Seems" tonight at 8:30 p. m. over CBS-WBBM. The initial program also includes the true story of Paul Revere's ride, which differs greatly from the usual grammar school version.
