Nazimova Appears For First Time On Air In Clever Drama

Special Program Arranged For National Barn Dance; Songs To Have Rural Flavor

Nazimova, who once played second fiddle in an orchestra conducted by Tchaikovsky, will realize one of her life's ambitions when she plays the part of Madecja von Meek, the great Russian composer's "beloved friend" in "This Lonely Heart."

"This Lonely Heart" will deal mainly with the reactions of Madame von Meek. It will show her unremitting effort to help the selfish musician, both financially and as an adviser, and will disclose that in spite of the continual humiliations which she was forced to undergo, her love still enabled her to express her own genius and to live fully, rather than becoming stultified by the round of household duties which hedged the average Russian woman of her day.

The close association which has been formed between Nazimova and Oboler is almost as interesting as the relationship discussed in "This Lonely Heart," although from a totally different angle. It was after hearing one of Oboler's powerful dramatic programs that the great Russian actress offered to break her long-standing rule against appearing on the radio.
