(Special To The Lima News) VAN WERT, Oct. 5 - Distribution of \$56,947 is being made this week to Van Wert-co farmers and land owners who conformed with the 1939 corn and wheat programs.

The division of the total was \$2,457 for wheat payments and \$54,490 in corn payments.

Additional payments on corn and wheat, the sugar beet payments plus extra payments for compliance in the entirety of the conservation program is expected to boost the total payments for the county to nearly \$280,000.
