NEW YORK, Nov. 4—(AP)—Aircrafts advanced briskly today, well in front of an otherwise steady stock market.

On the plus side at the opening, on the basis of moderately large overnight orders, were Douglas Aircraft, Glenn Martin, Curtis Wright, United Aircraft, Western Union, Montgomery Ward, Chrysler and New York Central.

From various sectors of the domestic financial front favorable communiques continued in abundance.

Outstanding was the report of the federal reserve board that industrial production in October, as measured by the board's seasonally adjusted index, had reached the highest point since the autumn of 1929.

Producers of steel and electricity reported outputs topping the 1929 records.

Aviation authorities said they believed Great Britain and France were likely to double their airplane purchases in this country, now that military goods may be exported.

STUDENT HELD AFTER RALLY

CLEVELAND, Nov. 4—(AP)—A Western Reserve student faced charges of resisting an officer and two policemen nursed injuries today as an aftermath to a clash between students and police at a football rally.

Patrolman Frank Willigan suffered broken finger and Patrolman Henry G. Thorpe a stone-bruised back.

Robert Kuhman, 18, was released on bond after his arrest by Willigan, who said the youth tussled with him.

Willigan said the clash occurred with 500 students swarmed into University circle, the area surrounding the Western Reserve and Case campuses, last night after a bonfire pep meeting in preparation for today's homecoming game with Ohio Wesleyan. Traffic was tied up for nearly two hours.
